

SEWER COLLECTIONS FIELD OPERATOR

The Midvalley Improvement District is seeking a full-time sewer collections system Field Operator. A high school diploma or equivalent is preferred with one year experience working with wastewater collections and a current and valid Utah Commercial Driver's License (CDL). This person must be able to pass a test within one year to receive a minimum Class I Collection Operators certificate, be able to lift 75 pounds, have considerable skills in following directions, and be able to operate heavy equipment including sewer cleaning trucks, backhoes, and dump trucks in extreme weather conditions. The position operates under the direction of the Midvalley Improvement District Field Operations Supervisor.

Starting salary will be based on experience. Benefits include 4-day work weeks, health insurance, 401k, cafeteria plan, retirement, vacation, and sick leave.
